			(vi) What is the concept of response data referred in the Government order dated 11th May 2020;
			(vii) Under which contingencies, the status of a person who has downloaded Arogya Setu app is shown as either red or orange and in which cases, yellow and green colours are displayed.
			3. The learned Senior Counsel appearing for the petitioner states that he will place a memo and necessary materials on record within a period of 10 days from today.
			4. Let the petition be listed on 26th November 2020 at 12.45 p.m. for further hearing on the prayer of interim relief.
			5. It will be appropriate if even the Government of India places necessary documents on record within a period of 10 days from today dealing with the aforesaid factual aspects.
